• This week a group of our **Year 10 and 11 pupils** attended a **cyber challenge** hosted by the Army at Blandford Forum Barracks. Our pupils did very well, with our Year 11 team coming 4th overall and successfully completing the challenge, which was to prevent a cyber attack by cracking codes. Our Year 10 pupils made an admirable effort and certainly learned the value of teamwork to get such a tricky challenge completed. They are already planning their winning team for next year! In the afternoon the pupils joined in building a robot with Raspberry Pi, controlled a robot using a mobile phone, used some of the Army's technology to plan a rescue mission for an injured soldier under fire, and took part in activities concerning cyber security and ethical hacking. It was a great day and the pupils who took part were fantastic and excellent role models for our school.

• On **Monday Years 10 and 11 are having a LifeSkills workshop**, the first of 4 workshops delivered by the Talent Foundry and Barclays Bank over the course of this academic year. LifeSkills helps young people develop skills and confidence for life and work.
